Sandra Aldana, PhD, adjunct professor in Cal Lutheran's Public Health Program, will lead a conversation about disability inclusion issues in our society. She will highlight how people with and without disabilities come together to form strong, diverse communities. This discussion will raise awareness about the inclusion of people with disabilities in all facets of community life, as well as awareness of the barriers that people with disabilities still sometimes face in connecting to the communities in which they live.
