Latinx Queer Trans Leadership: A Movement for Freedom in the U.S. South Thursday, Oct. 19 | 12:25-2:05 p.m.

Swenson 101

Social-movement historian and longtime organizer Rafael Solórzano traces the roots of Latinx freedom movements in the U.S. South. From the perspective of a participant-observer, Solórzano maps the strategies and mobilizations led by women of color and queer trans leadership within migrant rights organizations in Florida and Georgia.

Inspired by Gloria Anzaldua, who contended that Chicanos listen to what their queer trans siblings are saying, and Robin D.G. Kelley, who teaches us to think of the South as the most radical place in the country, Solórzano offers an analysis that uplifts regional Southern campaigns and lesser-known leaders as visionaries and vanguards of racial justice movements.
