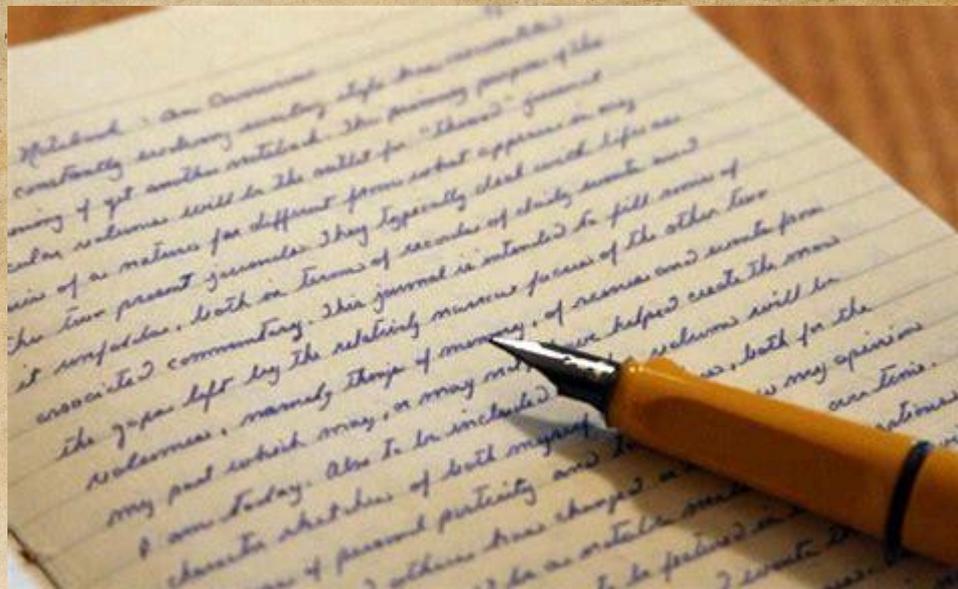
Writing approach

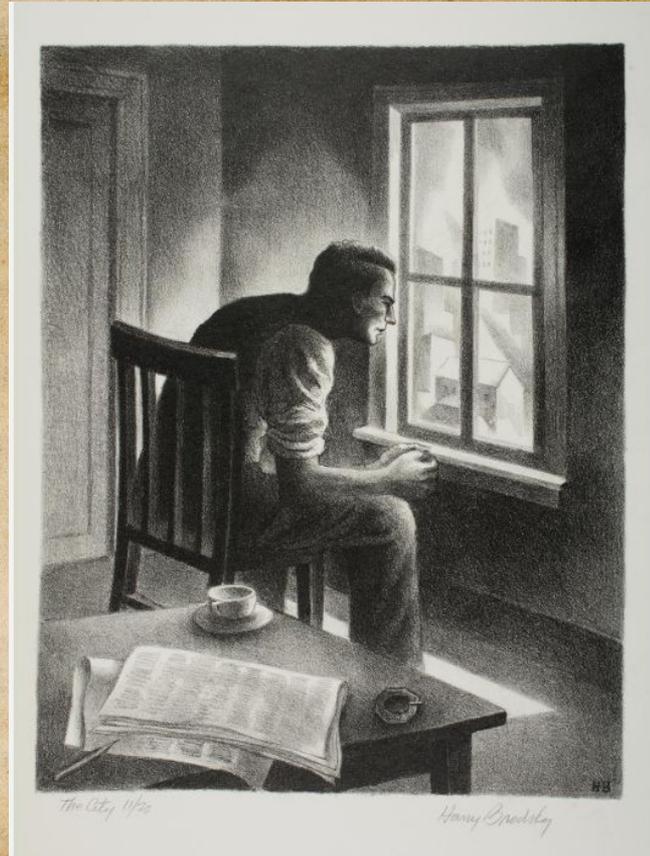

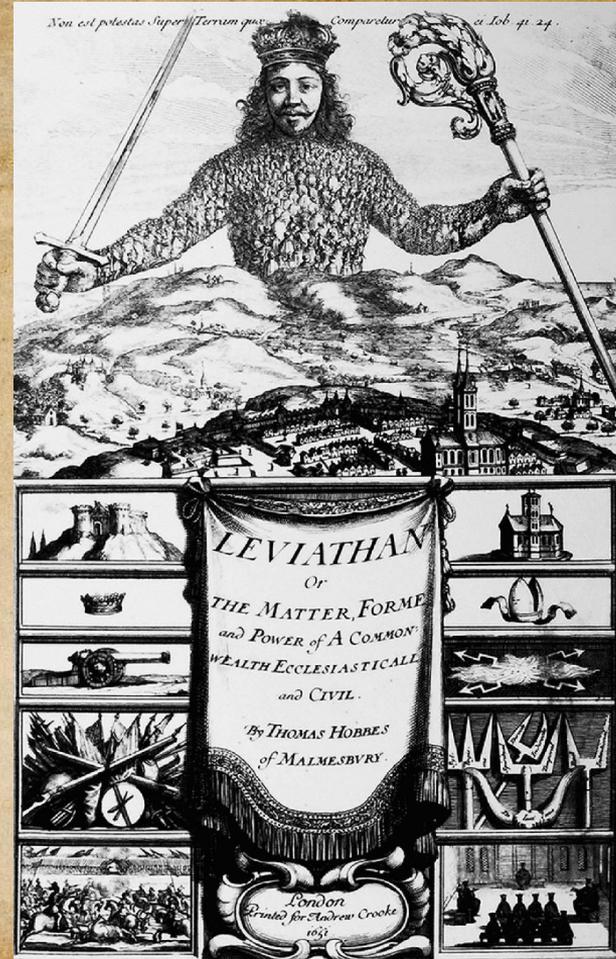
